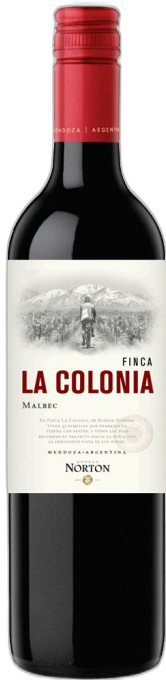


Finca La Colonia Malbec 2025,

PRODUCER

Founded in 1895 at the foot of the Andes in Mendoza, Bodega Norton is one of Argentina's most historic estates, farming its own vineyards in Lujan de Cuyo and the Uco Valley. Winemaking is led by chief winemaker David Bonomi.

VINEYARDS

Grown at Finca La Colonia in the west of Agrelo, at the foot of the Andes. The deep alluvial soils give Malbec firm, fine tannins.

TASTING NOTES

A bright, fruit-forward Malbec that expresses all the fruit and freshness of the variety. The palate is rich and elegant, closing on a long, harmonious finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Grilled and roasted red meats, empanadas and aged cheeses. Serve at 16 to 18 C.
