PRODUCER

Founded in 1895 at the foot of the Andes in Mendoza, Bodega Norton is one of Argentina's most historic estates, farming its own vineyards in Lujan de Cuyo and the Uco Valley. Winemaking is led by chief winemaker David Bonomi.

VINEYARDS

Malbec is picked early from the Finca La Colonia estate to keep the natural acidity and delicate colour that define this style of rose.

TASTING NOTES

Delicate salmon pink. The nose shows the floral character of Malbec with juicy red fruits. The palate is dry and zippy, with fresh acidity and a clean finish.

SERVICE

Serve chilled at 8 to 10 C with salads, sushi, charcuterie and light summer dishes.
